

## **SUMMER CAMP 2020 QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

### **Q: HOW WILL REGISTRATION WORK THIS SUMMER?**

Registration will be on a first- come, first- serve basis with registration available through the NOR website, with staff assistance over the phone. District facilities will be closed to the public so there will be no in- person/in- facility registration. No 'waitlist' or 'holding' of participant registration. All participants shall complete [CAPRI COVID-19 Waiver] at the time of registration.

### **Q: WHAT IS THE REFUND POLICY?**

Refunds shall not be issued for any summer/day camp or program that must be closed due to COVID-19 exposure.

### **Q: WHAT CAN WE EXPECT WITH PROGRAMMING?**

You can expect activities to continue as planned with summer camp but with a few modifications to accommodate for social distancing. Participants will be able to enjoy activities both inside and outside of the facility. They will be placed in smaller groups and will be encouraged to maintain a 6ft distance. There will be no sharing of objects.

### **Q: WILL MY CHILD GO SWIMMING THIS SUMMER?**

No, unfortunately due to the current COVID-19 pandemic the pool will be closed.

### **Q: WITH THE CHANGES FROM COVID-19, WHAT SHOULD I SEND MY CAMPER TO CAMP WITH EACH DAY?**

Please make sure to send your child with a mask, plenty of water, and with enough food for AM Snack, Lunch, and PM Snack. Like past summer camps NOR will not be providing lunch or snacks. Participants will not be allowed to share food with others and there will be no water fountains available.

### **Q: WHY ARE SIBLINGS PAIRED TOGETHER?**

Siblings are paired together as they are already sharing space at home. The idea is to limit the amount of potential contact between unrelated campers. Our rec leaders will create programming that is adaptable to different ages and developmental abilities to make sure everyone is engaged at an age-appropriate fun level!

### **Q: WHAT DOES DAILY CHECK-IN LOOK LIKE?**

There will be an assigned drop-off and pick-up location outside the Greenacres facility to minimize the number of people entering the building. Parent must sign their child in and out of the program at the beginning and end of the day. You can drop your child and pick them up at any time by calling the Greenacres office at 392-2010.

### **Q: WILL MY CHILD BE ABLE TO GO OUTSIDE?**

Yes! Being outside in the open air is an important part of summer AND open air happens to be better for preventing the spread of COVID-19. Recreation Leaders will ensure that campers are spending time outside in accordance with CDC guidelines.

### **Q: WILL PARTICIPANTS BE USING PLAYGROUNDS THIS SUMMER?**

Campers will be permitted to use the playground in strict rotation. Staff will disinfect the playground between each use with adequate rest time between groups.

### **Q: WHAT PRECAUTIONS IS NOR TAKING TO LIMIT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 AMONGST PARTICIPANTS?**

Beyond increased cleaning and sanitizing, participants will be expected to partake in additional handwashing, wear facemasks, and exercise social distancing practices as much as possible, even within small groups. Additional information and expectations will be outlined within the required camper forms and CAPRI COVID-19 Waiver form.
