



*The following outline is the recommended course of action regarding poor air quality, excessive heat, and any other hazardous weather conditions for outdoor activities:*

## **Poor Air Quality**

**Air Quality Index (AQI) 170 or higher (red - unhealthy range)**

- All practices and games are cancelled.

## **Heat**

**Excessive Heat** – If the temperature reaches 106 degrees or above, **ALL** outdoor activities are canceled. If the temperature is between 103 – 105 degrees, games will be delayed **and** start at 6:00 p.m. Game times for pitching machine leagues will be 6:00, 7:15, and 8:30 p.m. (1 hr 10 minute games), Coach Pitch 6:00 & 7:05 p.m. (1 hour games) and Live Pitch 6:00 and 8:00 p.m. (1 hr. and 45 minute games). If an **Excessive Heat Warning** is issued by the National Weather Service, all outdoor events will be cancelled. **Any canceled games will not re-scheduled.**

## **Dust**

In the event either a Dust Storm Warning or Blowing Dust Advisory is issued by the National Weather Service, all outdoor events will be cancelled and **not** rescheduled.

In the event of any of the above advisories are called by the National Weather Service, an email will be sent out to all coaches no later than 4:00 p.m. **Cancelled games will not be rescheduled.**
