HOURLY PART TIME POSITIONS – VARIOUS PROGRAMS

Come and join our team! Individual programs utilize hourly part time positions throughout the year.

Junior Theatre – Instructors and Recreation Leaders are needed based on the needs of the individual shows. Director, Assistant Director, Choreographer, Vocal Director, Stage Manager, Technical Director, Set-Design, Make-up/Costumer.

Upcoming productions: Peter Pan, performances in July; Teen Scene – Disney's Newsies, performances in October; A Christmas Story, performances in December.

Spring and Summer Day Camps – Recreation Coordinators and Recreation Leaders work the day camps for children ages 6-12. Spring 1 week session, Summer 9 weeks.

Senior Adult Center programs/rentals – Recreation Leaders are assigned during facility rentals and are responsible for the oversight of the facility during rentals, while being available for the needs and concerns of the renters.

QUALIFICATIONS: A combination of training and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities to successfully perform the essential functions of this position. Must have some knowledge of the specific assignment or activity and operation of a computer helpful. Must be able to accommodate the work schedule; interact courteously with others; communicate effectively; understand and follow written and/or oral instructions; work with large or small groups; and work with minimal supervision. Must also be able to relate to other people beyond giving and receiving instructions; can get along with co-workers or peers without exhibiting behavioral extremes; perform work activities requiring negotiating, instructing, supervising, persuading or speaking with others; and respond appropriately to criticism from a supervisor.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORK ENVIRONMENT: May be assigned to work in any of the following work environments: office, classroom, warehouse, gymnasium, various sports courts/fields. Facility and/or activity set-up, take-down, and clean-up. Some lifting may be required. Regularly interacts and communicates with participants, co-workers, supervisors, and the public.
